For 15 years, there have been a number of heartening and promising research leads into the microbiota, but the fact remains that we have a long way to go before we can prevent or cure diseases related to the microbiota.

To help advance research, Biocodex is launching the Biocodex Microbiota Foundation (BMF), a fully independent organization which is self-funded, guided by an independent board of directors, and a scientific committee composed of independent scientific experts.

The Biocodex Microbiota Foundation will fund research projects focused on the microbiota at two levels: national and international. Projects will be evaluated and then selected by scientific committees composed of independent experts.

INTERNATIONAL LEVEL

A call is sent out each year for projects on a specific topic related to the microbiota. The international scientific committee selects the projects to be supported and funded by the BMF. The theme for 2018 is "Liver Diseases and Gut Microbiota."

NATIONAL LEVEL

National calls for projects will be sent out progressively in France, Belgium, Russia, Ukraine, the U.S., Canada, Morocco, Mexico, Baltic and Scandinavian countries, and Poland. The program will allow new research projects to be undertaken by research teams interested in the role of the microbiota in human health.
